

CONDITIONS GOVERNING SENIOR AGE GROUP & MASTERS SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIPS

- 1) General Conditions shall apply, excluding conditions 8 & 9.
- 2) When a person is a member of more than one Surrey club he/she may compete for either Club, providing that only one Club is represented during one Championship, and the person has been a member of that Club for at least three months prior to the Championship.

When a person is a member of more than one Surrey club he/she may compete for either Club, providing that only one Club is represented during one Championship, and the person has been a member of that Club for at least three months prior to the Championship.

A swimmer who resigns from a Surrey club and at the same time joins another Surrey club, must immediately inform the promoter of any competition for which he is entered. Points scored before the swimmer changes club shall be unchanged. Thereafter the swimmer shall not score points for any club, and may not swim in a relay team. He may however swim in any individual event for which he is entered.

- 3) Age groups shall be as follows:
Senior 18-24 years
Masters 25 years and over, in five year age bands. Age bands for individual events are to extend as far as necessary to accommodate the ages of all competitors, e.g.

Age bands for Relay events are

Senior
120 - 159
160 – 199
200 – 239
240+

The age of a Relay team is the combined ages of the individual team members. A Senior Relay consists of at least one swimmer who is in the Senior Age Group, 18 - 24. (e.g. one Senior swimmer and three Masters swimmers of any age constitutes a Senior Relay)
A mixed Team shall consist of two Females and two Males swum in any order.

Ages of individuals to be as at 31st December in the year of the competition.

- 4) Individual events in all strokes and Individual Medley shall be held.
Freestyle and Medley Relays shall be held in all four age groups, for Female, Male and Mixed teams. A Mixed team consists of two Females and two Males.

5) In the Sprint Championships, the distances swum shall be:

Individual Medley	100m	200m
Freestyle Relay	4x25m	4x50m
Medley Relay	4x25m	4x50m

In any other Championship, the distances swum shall be:

	Minimum	Maximum
Butterfly	100m	200m
Breaststroke	100m	200m
Backstroke	100m	200m
Freestyle	100m	800m
Individual Medley	100m	400m

6) All events shall be Heat Declared Winners, and all age groups will swim together in pre-seeded heats.

7) No limit shall be placed on the number of entries an individual may make in any one Championship.

A Club may enter one or more Relays in any age group, but members shall swim for one team only.

8) Entry fees shall be determined by the Executive and shall be stated on the entry form. No entries will be accepted without accompanying entry fees. The promoter of the Championships reserves the right to reject entries, due to over-subscription. The method of rejection is to be agreed by the Executive.

9) Medals shall be awarded for those placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd, in all events in all age groups, for individual and team events.

Points shall be awarded for individual and team events for 1st to nth places, where n is the number of lanes used during the Championships.

Victor Ludorums shall be awarded to Master swimmers achieving the highest aggregate from the Sprint Championships within 10 year age bands for each sex, i.e 25 - 34, 35 - 44, 45 - 54, 55 - 64, etc. These awards, (whose form may vary from time to time), are retained by the winners.

Three perpetual trophies shall be awarded to those Clubs achieving the highest aggregate from the Sprint Championships for:

- Ladies events
- Mens events
- Relay events

These trophies shall be held for one year, and returned to the Trophies Honorary Secretary prior to the next Sprint Championships, with the appropriate engraving. (N.B. The cost of the engraving may be recouped from the County.)
