GENERAL CONDITIONS for DIVING CHAMPIONSHIPS

(Note: General Conditions Governing Championships shall also apply except item 3 below)

- 1 The international technical rules of diving shall be used in all diving championships whenever possible.
- 2 All age group competitors remain qualified from 1st January to the following 31st December at the age they are at the close of the day, (midnight) on 31st December of the year of competition. Age groups shall be defined for all championships thus:

GROUP E: Women and Men 19 years and over in the year of competition

GROUP A: Girls and Boys with 16th, 17th or 18th birthday in year of competition

GROUP B: Girls and Boys with 14th or 15th birthday in the year of competition

GROUP C: Girls and Boys with 12th or 13th birthday in the year of competition

GROUP D2: Girls and Boys with 10th or 11th birthday in the year of competition

GROUP D1: Girls and Boys with 8th or 9th birthday in the year of competition

- 3 Junior is defined as 8 to 18 years of age (inclusive) in the year of championship.
- 4 Disputes. Any dispute or question arising, that the foregoing conditions do not provide, shall be determined as the Executive may decide.
- 5 In all Championships each competitor shall submit a completed dive sheet either:
 - i) to be received by the Diving Hon. Secretary before the championship; or*
 - ii) to the designated recorder at least one hour before the commencement of the first event.
- 6 In all Championships dive positions can be altered up to one hour before the start of the first event.
- 7 Entries must be made on the prescribed combined entry form and dive sheet, obtainable from and returnable to: The SCWPSA Honorary Diving Secretary or other nominated person, which must state the date of birth of the competitor. The Honorary Secretary of the competitor's Club must confirm on this form that the given date of birth is correct.

ENTRIES ACCOMPANIED BY AN ENTRANCE FEE FOR EACH COMPETITOR AS DETERMINED BY THE EXECUTIVE MUST REACH THE DIVING COMMITTEE HON. SECRETARY, OR OTHER NOMINATED PERSON, NOT LATER THAN THE CLOSING DATE STIPULATED.

- 8 A County Diving Proficiency Badge shall be awarded to competitors who obtain not less than 120 points in the Springboard or 100 points in the Highboard Junior Championships provided that they have not previously been awarded one.

CONDITIONS FOR BOARD CHAMPIONSHIPS

1 metre Springboard:

Junior (Girls and Boys): Five voluntary dives from different groups, the total degree of difficulty of which shall not exceed 9.5 and three different voluntary dives without limit.

Women: As for Junior 1 metre but the three dives without limit shall be selected from a different group.

Men: As for Junior 1 metre but the three dives without limit shall be selected from a different group.

3 metre Springboard:

Junior (Girls and Boys): Five voluntary dives from at least three different groups.

Women: Seven voluntary dives from at least five different groups.

Men: Eight voluntary dives from at least five different groups.

Highboard:

Junior (Girls and Boys): Five voluntary dives from at least four different groups: 5 metres and/or 7½ metres only.

Women: Six voluntary dives from at least four different groups: 5 metres, 7½ metres and/or 10 metres.

Men: Seven voluntary dives from at least five different groups: 5 metres, 7½ metres and/or 10 metres.

Forward and or back jumps are not allowed in the Board Championships. A dive of the same number may not be repeated in the same event.

CONDITIONS FOR AGE GROUP CHAMPIONSHIPS

Group E	Five different dives.
Group A	Six different voluntary dives from at least five groups.
Group B	Five different voluntary dives from at least four groups.
Group C	Four different voluntary dives from at least three groups.
Group D2	Four different dives from at least two groups.
Group D1	Four different dives from at least two groups.

A maximum of 1 jump shall be allowed in Age Group Championships, which will have a tariff of 0.6. A dive of the same number may not be repeated in the same event.

CONDITIONS FOR 'CLOSED' & 'OPEN' NOVICE PLAIN DIVING CHAMPIONSHIPS

In each group there will be two championships:

- (1) A Closed Championship which is only for members of Clubs, Schools or School Associations affiliated to the SCWP&SA and who meet the age requirements specified in General Condition 2 above.

(2) An Open Championship for divers who are members of any organisation that is affiliated either directly or indirectly through its parent body to the ASA and who meet the age requirements specified in General Condition 2 above.

(3) In championships (1) and (2) above, competitors must not have:

- (a) dived in a National or Regional Championship
- or (b) dived in National or Regional Age Group Competition
- or (c) won the age section of this championship for which they are otherwise eligible (except for Group A where this shall not apply)

(4) In each group the competitors will dive in one event but the respective places for the open or closed championship will be extracted from the results of that event.

Boys and Girls in Group A shall perform 5 dives:

- (1) Forward Dive 1 metre Springboard, in tucked or piked position only
- (2) Forward Dive 1 metre Springboard, in tucked or piked position only
- (3) Forward Dive 3 metre Springboard, in tucked or piked position only
- (4) Forward Dive 3 metre Springboard, in tucked or piked position only
- (5) Forward Dive 5 metre Highboard, in tucked or piked position only

Boys and Girls in Group B shall perform 5 dives:

- (1) Forward Dive 1 metre Springboard, in tucked or piked position only
- (2) Forward Dive 1 metre Springboard, in tucked or piked position only
- (3) Forward Dive 3 metre Springboard, in tucked or piked position only
- (4) Forward Dive 3 metre Springboard, in tucked or piked position only
- (5) Forward Dive 5 metre Highboard, in tucked or piked position only

Boys and Girls in Group C shall perform 4 dives:

- (1) Forward Dive 1 metre Springboard, in tucked or piked position only
- (2) Forward Dive 1 metre Springboard, in tucked or piked position only
- (3) Forward Dive 3 metre Springboard, in tucked or piked position only
- (4) Forward Dive 3 metre Springboard, in tucked or piked position only

Boys and Girls in Groups D1 & D2 shall perform 4 dives:

- (1) Forward Dive 1 metre Springboard, in tucked or piked position only
- (2) Forward Dive 1 metre Springboard, in tucked or piked position only
- (3) Forward Dive 1 metre Springboard, in tucked or piked position only
- (4) Forward Dive 1 or 3 metre Springboard, in tucked or piked position only

Application will be made to the ASA Registration Officer for this championship to be deemed a low-level competition.

CONDITIONS FOR 'CLOSED' & 'OPEN' NOVICE DIVING CHAMPIONSHIPS

With the exception of the dives to be performed, the conditions for these Novice Championships shall be the same as the Closed and Open Novice Plain Diving Championships above.

Boys and Girls in Groups D1, D1 & C shall perform 4 dives:

- (1) 101C Forward dive with tuck,
- (2) 201 Back dive (straight, or piked or with tuck, but dd of 1.5 to count),
- (3) 401C Inward dive with tuck,
- (4) One optional dive (can be a repeat, but if it is it shall have a tariff of 1.0), all from one metre Springboard. Forward and or back jumps are not allowed.

Boys and Girls in Groups A & B shall perform 5 dives:

- (1) 101C Forward dive with tuck,
- (2) 201 Back dive (straight, or piked or with tuck, but dd of 1.5 to count),
- (3) 401C Inward dive with tuck,
- (4&5) Two optional dives (can be repeats, but must be different from each other and shall each have a tariff of 1.0 if a repeat) all from one metre Springboard. Forward and or back jumps are not allowed.

Optional dives entered on the prescribed forms can be altered up to one hour before the start of the first event.

Application will be made to the ASA Registration Officer for this championship to be deemed a low-level competition.

THE JIMMY ALDOUS TROPHY

- (1) The championship shall be open to all clubs or sections affiliated to the SCWP&SA.
- (2) Points shall be awarded for placing in the SCWP&SA 1m Age Group Diving Championships as follows;
1st 10 points, 2nd 7 points, 3rd 6 points, 4th 5 points, 5th 4 points, 6th 3 points, 7th 2 points and 8th 1 point.
- (3) The club or section with the greatest number of points when all 1m Age Group Championship results are taken together shall be deemed the winner of the trophy which shall be held only until the following year's 1m Age Group Championships.

Due to time constraints the SCWPSA diving committee, having given much thought to the problem, has agreed it will be necessary to continue to combine the 'junior' and 'senior' 3 metre championships. Divers wishing to compete in both championships shall use only one dive sheet on which the dives must meet the requirements of the Senior Championship. Different dives for the two events will not be permitted. Coaches and divers are also reminded that for divers in the senior events **the first five dives must conform to the junior conditions and the total points scored on those five dives will be counted as the junior event result.**
