## GENERAL RULES

### 1. Name

The Competition Committee of Surrey County ASA (incorporating SCWP&SA).

For competition purposes the County of Surrey consists of the eleven boroughs in the administrative county of Surrey together with the London boroughs of Croydon, Southwark, Lambeth, Wandsworth, Merton, Sutton, the Royal Borough of Kingston-upon-Thames and the Royal Borough of Richmond.

### 2. Objectives

The objectives of the Competition Committee are:

- a) To promote and conduct competitions and Championships in the disciplines of Water Polo, Diving, Swimming and Synchronized Swimming within the County
- b) To select and govern teams and individuals to represent the County.

### 3. Eligibility

All Clubs which are affiliated to the ASA and whose headquarters are situated within the County Association boundaries shall be eligible for entry to the competitions.

### 4. Committee

The Committee shall consist of:

President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer and representatives of the various disciplines and Disability secretary, Trophies secretary, Swimming Officials secretary, Welfare Officer and Inter-Counties Team Manager.

### 5. Forum

A Forum shall be held at least once per year to enable discussion between clubs & Competition committee members.

### 6. Honorary Members

Surrey County ASA shall have power to nominate Honorary Life Members and Honorary Life Vice-Presidents at its discretion for election at the Annual Council Meeting of Surrey County ASA as recommended by each discipline subject to the rules below:

Members who have provided outstanding service to, or have bestowed honour on the County may be considered for Honorary Life Vice-Presidency.

Members who have competed for the County and participated in the Olympics, European Championships, Commonwealth Games, World Championships, or other competitions subject to approval by the Management Committee may be considered for Honorary Life Membership. Masters may be considered for Honorary Life Membership who: i) satisfy County qualifications, **and** ii) have obtained a world record, or won a gold medal in the World Masters Age Groups, **and** iii) have made some other contribution.

## 7. Sectional Committees

The Competition committee will decide its own sectional committee structure & have delegated authority unless their decisions affect other disciplines. They are responsible for all matters relevant to that discipline and must prepare an annual budget. Expenditure on any item must not exceed their budget for that item without express permission of the Management Committee. Minutes must be sent to the Management Committee.

Sectional Committees shall comprise Swimming Championships, Masters, Diving, Synchronized Swimming and Water Polo and Open Water.

Notes:

- i. Each Committee shall appoint a Chairman and has power to co-opt additional members and make such appointments as it sees fit to ensure the smooth running of the sport for which it is responsible subject to the jurisdiction of the Management Committee to whom it shall report.
- ii. All Committee members, including co-opted and ex-officio members shall have power to vote.
- iii. The President, Vice-President, Treasurer and Secretary shall be ex officio members of all Sectional Committees.
- iv. A quorum shall be half of the Committee's membership.
- v. Each Committee member shall have a single vote. The Chairman shall have one vote as a member of the Committee and an additional casting vote as Chairman in the event of a tied vote. If the Chairman does not wish to exercise his casting vote in the event of a tied vote, then the motion shall fail.

## 8. County Qualifications

Subject to any specific conditions relating to Championships and competitions a person shall qualify for Surrey County purposes by membership of a club that is affiliated to the County Association.

## 9. County Shirts

- a) A County shirt shall be awarded to each competitor on the first occasion they represent the County in an event approved by the Competition Committee.
- b) Technical Officials

Those who have passed an examination approved by the ASA and who have been placed on the County List shall be permitted to purchase a County shirt with the words "County Official" added.

## **10. Trophies**

All Trophies shall be perpetual. The winner, or the club of a winning team, may hold a trophy upon giving satisfactory undertaking to the Association for its safe custody and due return upon demand, in the condition in which it was received. All trophies shall be insured at the expense of the County in a manner to be decided by the Competition Committee.

## **11. Interpretation of Rules**

The Competition Committee shall have power to decide all matters concerning the interpretation of these Rules, and to deal with all matters not provided for therein.

## **12. Child protection and ethical policy**

a) Members of the Association shall in accordance with the ASA Laws comply with the ASA Child Protection Procedures. The Association will follow the guidance contained in the ASA handbook.

The Association is committed to treat everyone equally within the context of their activity, regardless of sex, ethnic origin, religion, disability, or political persuasion.

The Association believes that the welfare of children is everyone's responsibility and that all children have a right to have fun, be safe and protected from harm.

The Association is committed to the ASA Code of Ethics (which applies to all members of the ASA), including the Notes for Guidance, and the ASA Guidelines for handling Internal Disputes.

b) All persons acting for the Association in any capacity where they might be on their own with a child or children must complete an ASA Child Protection Registration application.

**GENERAL CONDITIONS GOVERNING COMPETITIONS PROMOTED BY  
THE COMPETITION COMMITTEE OF SURREY COUNTY ASA**

(Incorporating General Rule 8)

See also the conditions specific to each discipline

**General**

- 1 All competitions shall be promoted on behalf of the Competition Committee by the Secretary of the appropriate committee or by a person authorised by the appropriate committee.
- 2 All competitions shall be conducted upon dates and at venues to be agreed by the relevant sectional committee.
3. All events shall be held in the order printed in the programme, unless amendment is required for the purpose of correcting administrative errors of fact.

**Eligibility**

- 4 All competitors must be registered in accordance with ASA Law in the name of the club for which they are entered.
- 5 Competitors shall qualify for Surrey competitions by affiliation to Surrey County ASA, either affiliated as an individual or as a member of an affiliated club, for the three months prior to the closing date for entries.
- 6 Eligibility to compete shall be as set out in rule 5 above except that persons who have taken part in the County Championships of any other county in the current calendar year shall not be eligible.
7. The Competition Committee shall have the power to grant dispensation to compete in the County Championships in exceptional circumstances.
- 8 When a person is a member of more than one Surrey club, he/she may only compete in the name of the Surrey club with which he/she has the longest current unbroken membership i.e. the first Surrey club of their ASA Registration in the relevant discipline.
- 9 A person entered in a Surrey competition in the name of one club may not be entered in the name of another club in the same discipline.

**Entries:**

- 10 Entries shall be made on the official forms and must reach the promoter, accompanied by the fee, by the date specified.
- 11 The entry fees shall be proposed by the Sectional Committee approved by the Competition Committee and shall be stated on the entry forms.

## CONDITIONS GOVERNING SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIPS

- 1 General Conditions Governing Competitions shall apply.
- 2 The combined scores of an all-female club, and an all-male club, in the same locality, may, with the express permission of the Competition Committee, be considered as a 'joint' club for the Tinlin Trophy only.
- 3 A swimmer, who resigns from a Surrey club and at the same time joins another Surrey club, must immediately inform the promoter of any competition for which he is entered. Points scored before the swimmer changes club shall be unchanged. Thereafter the swimmer shall not score points for any club and may not swim in a relay team. He may however swim in any individual event for which he is entered.
- 4 Events  
These will be decided annually by the Age Group Committee.
- 5 Individual events  
Medals will be awarded to the swimmers with the three fastest times in every Age Group event. Ribbons will be awarded to the remaining 4<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> fastest in the 'Bagcat Category' Age Group events (Girls 9 – 13 years, and Boys 9 – 14 years).  
  
Category awards will be made to the three swimmers with the most British Age Group Points in each Category Age Group, Girls 9 –13 years, Boys 9 – 14 years. Certificates will be awarded to the 8 swimmers with the greatest number of points in each category **taken from the heats.**  
  
Medals/ribbons and scoring points will only be awarded where qualifying times are achieved.  
  
Trophies (*where available*) will be awarded to Junior, Senior and Open County Champions:
  - 5a) Competitors in the Junior Championships shall be 15 years of age or under, and competitors in the Senior Championships shall be 16 years of age or over as *at the last day of the series of Competitions.*
  - 5b) In all relevant events, the Junior Champion shall be the fastest Junior, and the Senior and Open Champions shall be determined in the same manner. Juniors are not eligible to become Senior Champions or medal winners
- 6 Team Events
  - 6a) Team events shall consist of combined Age Group events (9/10/11, 12/13 years) and Junior and Senior Championships. Junior swimmers are not eligible to swim in Senior (Men's and Ladies) team events.
  - 6b) Clubs may not enter more than the number of teams defined each year by the Competition Committee in a team swimming championship, and members shall swim for one team only. Any swimmer may be replaced by a reserve in the final from the original team submission of six swimmers.

7 Licensed times

The entry form shall contain a declaration that the entrant has achieved his/her submitted entry time from a licensed meet within the period from the day after the last day of the previous Championships to the entry closing date. The form must be signed by a member of the club who shall be held responsible for the accuracy of the times submitted. All times submitted must be to 1/100th of a second. Failure to comply with this requirement may lead to rejection of the entry.

- 1 The Competition shall be open to Ladies Clubs or Sections affiliated to Surrey County ASA.
- 2 Points shall be awarded for individual Ladies' and Girls' Swimming Championships as follows: 8,7,6,5,4,3,2,1, for the 8 fastest swimmers.
- 3 The Club obtaining the highest aggregate to hold the Jubilee Cup for one year and the Club obtaining the next highest aggregate to hold the Coronation Cup for one year.

**The St James' Centenary Trophy (Winner, Aggregate Points)  
Presented by ST. JAMES' S.C., 1979**

**The Shand Millennium Shield (Runner-up, Aggregate Points)  
Presented by Mrs PENNY SHAND, 2000**

1. The Competition shall be open to Men's Clubs or Sections affiliated to Surrey County ASA.
- 2 Points shall be awarded for individual Men's and Boys' Swimming Championships as follows: 8,7,6,5,4,3,2,1, for the 8 fastest swimmers.
- 3 The Club obtaining the highest aggregate to hold the St James' Centenary Trophy for one year and the club obtaining the next highest aggregate points to hold the Millennium Shield for one year.

**The George Tinlin (Aggregate Points)  
Age Group Trophy  
Presented by CRANLEIGH A.S.C., 1983**

- 1 The Competition shall be open to all clubs affiliated to Surrey County ASA.
- 2 Points shall be awarded for individual and team events in the Age Group Championships for ages 9 to 16 at the date specified in the 'Conditions Governing the Swimming Championships' only, as follows: 8,7,6,5,4,3,2,1, for the 8 fastest swimmers.
- 3 The Club obtaining the highest aggregate to hold the George Tinlin Trophy for one year. An all-female club and an all-male club in the same locality may, with the express permission of the Competition Committee, be considered as a 'joint' club for the Tinlin Trophy only.

## CONDITIONS FOR ESTABLISHING COUNTY SWIMMING RECORDS

- 1 All records shall be made in still water by swimmers who must possess County qualification. Any movement of water due to the normal operation of the filtration system may be disregarded.
- 2 All records will be for open and junior classification. The open classification (men and women) shall have no age limits. A Junior Record (boys and girls) will only be recognised if it is made by a swimmer who is 15 years of age or under on the date the record is made.
- 3 For all distances, the course shall not be less than 25 metres in length.
- 4 Records may be made in:
  - (a) A scratch competition held in public under A.S.A. laws provided that the Starter, Judges and Timekeepers are registered A.S.A. officials **or**
  - (b) By giving fourteen days clear notice to the Championship Honorary Secretary: An unpaced individual race against time, the date and venue of which must have been arranged and advertised as such before the day of the event and for which the Starter, Judges and Timekeepers must have been appointed by the Championship Honorary Secretary and who are registered ASA officials.
- 5 The time shall be determined in accordance with the appropriate ASA Law of Racing. If hand held timers are used to determine the time, there must be at least three timekeepers as in 4 above. Notification shall be by means of an official results sheet, or by an entry card with the record of the time signed by the Referee or other responsible official or officer.
- 6 Recognition of new records shall be established as follows:
  - (a) Details of records established in all events under shall be notified within twenty-eight days by the swimmer themselves or a representative on their behalf to the Championships Honorary Secretary.
  - (b) In the case of individual attempts under Rule 4(b), details shall be notified within fourteen days to the Honorary Championships Secretary by the Officials nominated.
  - (c) Records obtained in Surrey County Championships will automatically be recognised.
- 7 A Certificate of Record will be issued for every successful attempt upon request.
- 8 The following distances only will be recognised for County Records:

## **CONDITIONS GOVERNING SENIOR AGE GROUP & MASTERS SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIPS**

- 1) General Conditions shall apply, excluding conditions 6, 8 & 9.
- 2) When a person is a member of more than one Surrey club he may compete for either Club, providing that only one Club is represented during one Championship and the person has been a member of that Club for at least three months prior to the Championship.

A swimmer who resigns from a Surrey club and at the same time joins another Surrey club, must immediately inform the promoter of any competition for which he is entered. Points scored before the swimmer changes club shall be unchanged. Thereafter the swimmer shall not score points for any club and may not swim in a relay team. He may however swim in any individual event for which he is entered.

- 3) Age groups shall be as follows:

Senior 19-24 years

Masters 25 years and over, in five year age bands. Age bands for individual events are to extend as far as necessary to accommodate the ages of all competitors, e.g.

Seniors 18-24

A 25 - 29      B 30 - 34      C 35 - 39      D 40 - 44

E 45 - 49      F 50 - 54      G 55 - 59      H 60 - 64

J 65 - 69      K 70 - 74      L 75 - 79      M 80 - 84

N 85 - 89      P 90 - 94      Q 95 - 99      R 100 - 104 etc.

Age bands for Relay events are

Senior

120 – 159 years

160 – 199 years

200 – 239 years

240+ years

The age of a Relay team is the combined ages of the individual team members. A Senior Relay consists of at least one swimmer who is in the Senior Age Group, 19 - 24. (e.g. one Senior swimmer and three Masters swimmers of any age constitutes a Senior Relay).

A mixed Team shall consist of two Females and two Males swum in any order.

Ages of individuals to be as at 31st December in the year of the competition other than Seniors who must have reached 18 years on the day of the competition.

- 4) Individual events in all strokes and Individual Medley shall be held. Freestyle and Medley Relays shall be held in all four age groups, for Female, Male and Mixed teams. A Mixed team consists of two Females and two Males.

5) In the Sprint Championships, the distances swum shall be:

6) All events shall be Heat Declared Winners and all age groups will swim together in pre-seeded heats. The promoter of the event reserves the right to swim events as "Mixed" in order to improve the logistics of the Meet.

7) No limit shall be placed on the number of entries an individual may make in any one Championship. The promoter of the Championship reserves the right to reject entries due to over-subscription. The method of rejection is to be agreed by the Competition Committee.

A Club may enter one or more Relays in any age group, but members shall swim for one team only.

8) Entry fees shall be determined by the Competition Committee and shall be stated on the entry form.

No entries will be accepted without accompanying entry fees.

9) Medals shall be awarded for those placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd, in all events in all age groups, for individual and team events.

Points shall be awarded for individual and team events for 1st to n<sup>th</sup> places, where n is the number of lanes used during the Championships.

Victor Ludorum shall be awarded to Master swimmers achieving the highest aggregate from the Sprint Championships within 10 year age bands for each sex, i.e 25 - 34, 35 - 44, 45 - 54, 55 - 64, etc. These awards, (whose form may vary from time to time), are retained by the winners.

Four perpetual trophies shall be awarded to those Clubs achieving the highest aggregate from the Sprint Championships for:

- Ladies' events (individual events only)
- Men's events (individual events only)
- Relay events
- Over all points (for individual and team events combined)

These trophies shall be held for one year and returned to the Trophies Honorary Secretary prior to the next Sprint Championships, with the appropriate engraving. (N.B. The cost of the engraving may be recouped from the County).

## **DIVING**

### **GENERAL CONDITIONS for DIVING CHAMPIONSHIPS**

- 1 The FINA technical rules of diving shall be used in all diving championships whenever possible.
- 2 Age Group Championship competitors remain qualified from 1st January until midnight on 31st December in the year of competition. The age groups shall be defined thus:

GROUP F: Women and Men 19 years and over in the year of competition

GROUP A: Girls and Boys with 16th, 17th or 18th birthday in the year of competition

GROUP B: Girls and Boys with 14th or 15th birthday in the year of competition

GROUP C: Girls and Boys with 12th or 13th birthday in the year of competition

GROUP D: Girls and Boys with 10th or 11th birthday in the year of competition

GROUP E: Girls and Boys with 8th or 9th birthday in the year of competition

- 3 Junior is defined as 8 to 18 years of age (inclusive) in the year of the Championship.
- 4 Disputes. Any dispute or question arising that the foregoing conditions do not provide shall be determined as the Competition Committee may decide.
- 5 In all Championships each competitor shall submit a completed statement of dives to be received by the Diving Honorary Secretary, or designated recorder, not later than 5 days before the competition.
- 6 In all Championships a statement of dives can be altered up to one hour before the start of the first event.
- 7 Entries shall be made on the prescribed entry form, obtainable from and returnable to the Surrey County ASA Honorary Diving Secretary or other nominated person, which must state the date of birth of the competitor.

ENTRIES SHALL BE ACCOMPANIED WITH THE CORRECT ENTRY FEE AND MUST REACH THE DIVING COMMITTEE HONORARY SECRETARY, OR OTHER NOMINATED PERSON, NOT LATER THAN THE CLOSING DATE STIPULATED.

- 8 All diving Championships shall have Closed and Open events, from which results will be extracted as follows:
  - i) Closed events are only for members of Clubs, Schools or School Associations affiliated to Surrey County ASA.
  - ii) Open events are for members of any Club or Organisation affiliated to the ASA.

## CONDITIONS FOR BOARD CHAMPIONSHIPS

### 1 Metre Springboard

**Junior (Girls and Boys):** Five voluntary dives from different groups, the total degree of difficulty of which shall not exceed 9.5, and three different voluntary dives without limit.

**Senior (Women):** As for Junior 1 metre, but the three dives without limit shall be selected from a different group.

**Senior (Men):** As for Junior 1 metre, but the three dives without limit shall be selected from a different group.

### 3 Metre Springboard

**Junior (Girls and Boys):** Five voluntary dives from at least three different groups.

**Senior (Women):** Seven voluntary dives from at least five different groups.

**Senior (Men):** Eight voluntary dives from at least five different groups.

### Highboard

**Junior (Girls and Boys):** Five voluntary dives from at least four different groups: 5 metres and/or 7½ metres only.

**Senior (Women):** Six voluntary dives from at least four different groups: 5 metres, 7½ metres and/or 10 metres.

**Senior (Men):** Seven voluntary dives from at least five different groups: 5 metres, 7½ metres and/or 10 metres.

Jumps are not allowed in any Board Championships. A dive of the same number may not be repeated in the same event.

### **1 METRE JUNIOR AND SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS COMBINED**

When there are time constraints it will be necessary to combine the 1m Junior and Senior Championships. Eligible divers competing in both shall use only one dive sheet on which the dives will satisfy the Senior Championship conditions.

### **3 METRE JUNIOR AND SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS COMBINED**

When there are time constraints it will be necessary to combine the 3m Junior and Senior Championships. Eligible divers competing in both shall use only one dive sheet on which the dives will satisfy the Senior Championship conditions, with its first 5 dives satisfying the Junior Championship conditions. The points from the first 5 dives will be extracted for the Junior results.

Boys and Girls in Groups A & B shall perform 5 dives:

- (2) 201 Back dive (straight, piked or with tuck, but dd of 1.5 to count)

## **SYNCHRONIZED SWIMMING**

### **CONDITIONS**

1. General Conditions shall apply.
2. Closing date for entries shall be 21 days prior to the date of the competition.
3. Entry fees shall be as determined by the Management Committee.
4. The synchronized Swimming Sub-Committee shall have the power to decide any matter not covered by these conditions.

### **CHAMPIONSHIPS**

Technical Solo, Free Solo, Duet and Team

1. Competitors must hold Grade 3F & 3R or above of the A.S.A. Awards Scheme for synchronized swimming.
2. Juniors are not eligible to become Senior Champions in the Technical and Free Solo Competitions. Juniors shall be under 18 years of age on 31 December in the year of competition.
3. If there are more than 6 entries, only those with the 6 highest technical solo scores will qualify to swim the free solo.
4. The Duets and the Championship Team events will be Open. All competitors entering the duet and team competitions shall be eligible to swim.

### **INTERMEDIATE**

Figure, Solo, Duet and Team Competition

1. The Competition is open to swimmers holding A.S.A. Grade 2F & 2R of the A.S.A. Awards Scheme for synchronized swimming.
2. If there are more than 5 entries in each event, only those with the 5 highest figure scores for Solo and 5 highest combined figure scores for the Duet and Team will Bqualify to swim.

### **NOVICE**

Figure and Team Competition

1. The Competition is open to swimmers holding Grade 1F & 1R or below of the A.S.A. Awards Scheme for synchronised swimming.
2. The winner of the previous year's Novice competition shall not be eligible to compete in future years at novice level.

## **WATER POLO**

### **INTER-CLUB WATER POLO CHAMPIONSHIP for the "C.Norman-Jones," "F.E. Annison," "F.C. Reed"(Memorial) Cups (NOTE: General Conditions shall apply)**

1. The competition shall be conducted annually and shall be open to all Clubs affiliated to the Association.

2. Clubs desirous of taking part in the Championship shall give notice in writing to the Water Polo Hon. Competitions Secretary on or before 1st December in the year prior to that in which the competition is held, accompanied by the appropriate fee for each team entered, together with a contribution towards referees' expenses based on the total referees' expenses for the previous year, for each team entered. Fixtures shall be made at a meeting of Club Officials convened for that purpose; to be held as soon as possible after 1st January in the year of the competitions. A Club entered in the Competitions and not represented at the Fixture meeting, shall be liable to a fine of £10.

Competing Clubs shall submit to the Water Polo Hon. Competitions Secretary at least 14 days before the first league game, a list of names and addresses of their competing players for each competition or division entered. Clubs entering the Junior Competition shall submit at the same time a list of Junior competing players showing name, address and date of birth, duly certified by the Club Secretary. (Note: When a Club enters more than one open team at least seven players must be registered for each team entered; such registrations to be approved by the County Water Polo Committee. Should one or more players registered for the 1st team not play in one of the first two games then an equivalent number of players must be registered on the match form of the second game played. The original seven registrations plus the additions shall be eligible to play only for the 1st team unless special permission be given by the County Water Polo Committee. Junior players (under 18 in the year of competition) may play for either first or second teams with our restriction.

Reserves used as substitutes may be re-qualified to play for a lower team as provided under Rule 15.

Clubs wishing to qualify additional members may do so at the discretion of the Competition Committee. Junior players who have not been registered for a senior team may play without prior registration. His ASA registration number & address must be written in the match sheet.

3 (a) The Championship, which may be grouped according to districts at the discretion of the Competition Committee, shall consist of the First Division (for the C. Norman Jones Cup), the Second Division (for the F. E. Annison Cup), and the Junior Championship (for the F C Reed Cup).

(b) In each Championship the members of the winning team shall each receive a medal. Not more than eleven medals shall be awarded to each team. Players awarded medals must have played for the team.

4 A Club winning a Championship may have the relevant trophy on making written application to the Hon. Secretary of the Association, provided two guarantees are given to the satisfaction of the Competition Committee.

Any damage done to the trophy whilst it is in the possession of the holding club shall be made good at their expense.

5 (a) The First Division and Second Division shall consist of teams of Clubs selected by the Competition Committee from the entrants, subject to the proviso in Rule 6.

(b) The Junior Championship shall consist of Club players under 18 years of age on 1st January in the year of competition. The Competition may be divided into two or more divisions at the discretion of the Competition Committee.

6 In each year the winners of the Second Division of the previous year shall ascend to the First Division and the lowest Club in the First Division of the previous year shall, unless the Competition Committee decides otherwise, descend to the Second Division.

7 (a) The Championship shall be conducted on League lines, clubs playing each of the others in the same division, on a home and away match basis.

(b) The counting of points shall be: three points for a win, two points to each team for a draw, and one point for a team fulfilling a fixture but losing. No points will be awarded to a team which forfeits or concedes a match, or which attends a match with insufficient players to fulfil the fixture.

(c) The duration of matches shall be determined by the Water Polo Committee.

8 (a) In the event of two or more Clubs tying for first place in any division, the tie or ties shall be played off to a finish in a neutral bath, or in one mutually agreed upon.

(b) In the event of two or more Clubs tying for first place in any division a draw shall be made, A,B, and C; A shall play B to a finish, and the winner shall play C to a finish, the winner of the second game to be first in the division. The other two teams shall tie for second place in that division.

9 All matches shall be played before a date fixed by the Water Polo Committee.

10 The Club must give a least 10 days notification to the appointed referee concerning the time and the venue of the match.

11 (a) A Club wishing to scratch a match in any Competition must give at least seven days notice to the Water Polo Secretary of the opposing Club and to the Referee appointed, or to take at least five players with a view to playing a friendly game.

(b) In the event of a Club not being ready to start at the time arranged, the Referee shall award the game to their opponents, providing such opponents have seven eligible players present.

(c) A Club failing to carry out a fixture shall be liable to a fine not exceeding £5 together with such expenses of the fixture as the Water Polo Committee may determine.

12. (a) The result of each match, whether played or not, and the names of each team or part of each team (which shall be supplied by the respective Captains) together with the respective periods played by each player, if substitution has taken place, shall be forwarded by the Club Secretary to the Water Polo Hon. Competitions Secretary of the Association within three days.

(b) It is the responsibility of the home team Club Secretary to complete the match form and include details of the referee and the travel expenses being claimed.

13 No player shall be registered for more than one club in either the Senior or Junior Competition in any one season. The Competition Committee shall have power to take an exception to the above when the club has entered only the Senior Competition. In such a case a player wishing to play in the Junior Competition may apply to the Competition Committee in order that he may be considered by another club.

14 (a) Referees for the first division games shall be appointed by the Water Polo Competitions Secretary. No club shall have the power to object to any Referee after such appointment. Referees for the second division games shall be arranged by the home Club Secretary.

(b) Any Referee appointed for a match and unable to officiate, must provide a substitute from the South East Water Polo Referees list failing which any Referee shall, by mutual consent, be empowered to act.

15 No player representing his Club's first team shall be eligible to play in his Club's second team in the same year, except after having played as a substitute in the first team. Re-qualification of a substitution player, if eligible, shall be automatic, such re-qualification to take effect as from the day following such substitution. No player shall be re-qualified after playing in more than three games for a higher team in any one season. This condition shall not operate where the substitution has been made necessary by a player representing the County, District or Country in any capacity.

This condition does not apply to the Junior Competition except where a Club has more than one Junior team entered, then the condition shall apply within the Junior Competition.

16 Appeals or protests in a match must be notified to the Referee and the Captain of the opposing team at the conclusion of the match and a written statement of such appeal or protest lodged with the County Water Polo Competitions Secretary by the protesting team within five days. Such protest shall be accompanied by a deposit of £10 which may be forfeited if the appeal or protest be found to be frivolous.

17 Competitors shall not have taken part in another county's water polo championship or competition in the same year.

18 In addition to those qualifying by birth and residence, players who live outside the bounds of the county may take part in water polo events within the county if special permission is obtained from the Competition Committee.

19 In all games at home, away or in a neutral bath, each club shall wear its own caps. In a neutral bath the first named club shall be considered to be a home club.

### **CONDITIONS FOR COUNTY WATER POLO HANDICAP KNOCK-OUT COMPETITION ("TOM DWYER" MEMORIAL TROPHY)**

1 The competition shall be conducted annually and shall be open to all first and second teams of clubs affiliated to the Association.

2 Clubs wishing to participate shall give notice to the Water Polo Hon. Competitions Secretary in writing on or before the 1st October in each year accompanied by the appropriate entry fee.

3. A list of registered players shall be submitted by 1st November and this list must be approved by the County Water Polo Committee.

4. The competition shall be conducted on the knock-out principle, on a handicap basis, to be decided by the Water Polo Committee, subject to the winner of the previous year's First Division receiving a minimum handicap of 4 goals.

5. The draw and allocation of referees will be made by the Surrey County Water Polo Committee. The first team drawn of each pair shall be the home team and shall:

(a) notify the Water Polo Hon. Competitions Secretary of the date fixed for the match.

(b) notify the referee appointed, of the venue and the time of the match at least 10 clear days before the date thereof.

All matches in each round shall be completed before dates determined by the County Water Polo Committee.

6. In the event of the score being level at the expiration of time, extra time will be played in accordance with the A.S.A. Water Polo Rules.

7. Conditions 17, 18 and 19 from the Inter-club Water Polo conditions shall apply but Condition 17 may be waived if specific permission of the Water Polo Committee is obtained.

8. The Committee shall have the power to deal with any matter not provided for in the foregoing conditions.
